3. Contracts	
Any contract which is made between you or your husband/wife/civil partner (or a body in which you or your husband/wife/civil partner has a beneficial interest) and the City Council under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed and which has not been fully discharged.	
4. Land	Dispensation Granted by Monitoring Officer
Any beneficial interest in land held by you or your husband/wife/civil partner which is within the area of the City Council	
5. Licences	
Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to you or your husband/wife/civil partner to occupy land in Birmingham for a month or longer.	
6. Corporate tenancies	
Any tenancy where the landlord is the City Council and the tenant is a body in which you or your husband/wife/civil partner has a beneficial interest.	
7. Securities	
Any beneficial interest in which you or your husband/wife/civil partner has in securities of a body where:	
 (a) that body has a place of business or land in the area of the City Council; and (b) either: (i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total 	

- issued share capital of that body; or
- (ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you or a relevant person has a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

8. Personal Wellbeing

you also have a pecuniary interest where you a attend a meeting of the Council where the business concerns your personal wellbeing or financial position or that of your husband/wife/partner – to a greater extent than the majority of residents in your Ward affected by the decision.

You will only know this when you attend a meeting of the Council and an item on the agenda affects your wellbeing or that of your husband/wife/partner, to the extent described.

You must then declare a pecuniary interest at the beginning of the meeting or before the relevant item is discussed and not take part in the meeting when that agenda item is discussed.

Non-Pecuniary Interests
